Dear Laura,

Aboriginal Heritage Tasmania (AHT) has completed a search of the Aboriginal Heritage Register (AHR) regarding the proposed Wineglass Bay 2nd lookout and can advise that there are no Aboriginal heritage sites recorded within the proposed project area. Due to the nature of the landscape, it is believed that the project area has a low potential for Aboriginal heritage to be present.

Accordingly there is no requirement for an Aboriginal heritage assessment and AHT have no objection to the project proceeding, provided all works are strictly guided by the attached Unanticipated Discovery Plan.

Please be aware that there is a recorded Aboriginal heritage site within the surrounding area. The site is recorded as stone artefacts under a few granite overhangs. The site was recorded in the 1980s and details are minimal. Attached is AHT's stone artefact fact sheet, which provides a general description of stone artefacts.

Please be aware that all Aboriginal heritage is protected under the *Aboriginal Heritage Act 1975*. If at any time during works you suspect Aboriginal heritage, cease works immediately and contact AHT for advice. Attached is an Unanticipated Discovery Plan, which you should have on hand during ground disturbing works, to aid you in meeting your requirements under the Act.
