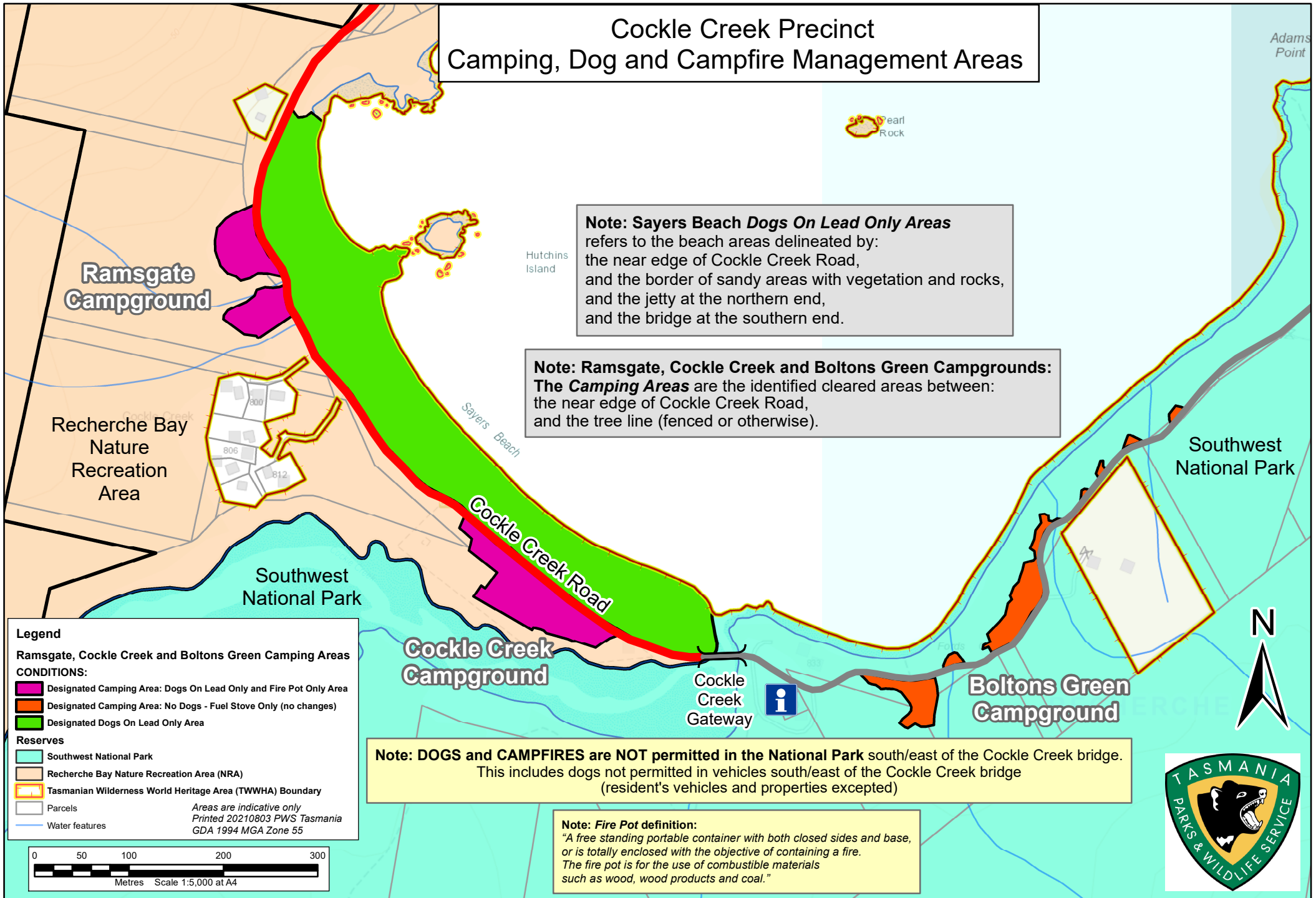


Cockle Creek Precinct Camping, Dog and Campfire Management Areas



Note: Sayers Beach Dogs On Lead Only Areas refers to the beach areas delineated by: the near edge of Cockle Creek Road, and the border of sandy areas with vegetation and rocks, and the jetty at the northern end, and the bridge at the southern end.

Note: Ramsgate, Cockle Creek and Boltons Green Campgrounds: The **Camping Areas** are the identified cleared areas between: the near edge of Cockle Creek Road, and the tree line (fenced or otherwise).

Note: DOGS and CAMPFIRES are NOT permitted in the National Park south/east of the Cockle Creek bridge. This includes dogs not permitted in vehicles south/east of the Cockle Creek bridge (resident's vehicles and properties excepted)

Note: Fire Pot definition:
"A free standing portable container with both closed sides and base, or is totally enclosed with the objective of containing a fire. The fire pot is for the use of combustible materials such as wood, wood products and coal."
